## Advanced Training

Several options are available in either one or two-day packages to better satisfy the individual needs of each participant. Whether you choose the one-day or more comprehensive two-day course, you'll quickly understand that this is not a typical classroom – it is a fully immersive experience into modern removable prosthodontics. Each section begins with a brief review of techniques with open



discussion followed by a step-by-step clinical demonstration with patients. You will then actively participate by

performing the techniques yourself with over-the-shoulder instruction, making this a worthwhile hands-on experience.

## Course Objectives

- Learn the titration method for delivering a final prosthesis eliminating most postoperative soreness.
- Learn how to take jaw recordings instead of bite records for total predictable occlusion.
- Learn how to make definitive impressions of the edentulous, partial denture, immediate denture and implant overdenture patient in just one visit.
- Adopt several different overdenture stud abutment systems to allow the practitioner a range to choose from.
- Master the implant overdenture direct pick-up method eliminating improper seating.

- Determine when to use angle abutments and learn a method to align malaligned abutments in minutes instead of hours.
- Determine when to use the mini implant vs. the conventional method.
- Understand how the clinical technique for the immediate denture has evolved to provide predictable results.
- Achieve postoperative equilibration in record time and learn how to significantly minimize postoperative appointments.

## Tulsa Course
